
Help With the Cost: KidSport and Jumpstart

Cost never decides whether a kid trains at Moose Jaw Boxing. Two programs pay a child's fees straight to the club, and we help you apply to both. Everything stays between your family and the club.

KidSport Moose Jaw

- ♦ **What it pays:** up to \$500 per child per calendar year toward registration fees, paid to the club. It does not cover gear, camps, travel, or clothing.
- ♦ **Who:** families facing financial barriers, kids aged 5 to 18.
- ♦ **When:** apply at least 30 days before the season starts. The last date for 2026 applications is December 11, 2026.
- ♦ **How:** go to kidsportcanada.ca/saskatchewan/moose-jaw and click Apply Online Now. Set up a profile, start an application, choose Chapter by List and pick Moose Jaw.
- ♦ **What to have ready:** the most recent Notice of Assessment for every adult in the home (CRA My Account) or a Proof of Income Statement, self-employment or farm income forms if they apply, assistance program documents, and the Disability Tax Credit letter if you have one. Missing income documents mean a declined application.
- ♦ **The program details to enter:** MJ Boxing Inc., operating as Moose Jaw Boxing. Your child's program and fee, for example "Youth Academy, season registration, September to June, \$55 per month, \$550 per season" or "Foundations six-week course, \$175".
- ♦ **Then:** KidSport decides within about 30 days and sends the grant to the club. Questions: kidsport@sasksport.ca (KidSport Saskatchewan now handles the Moose Jaw chapter's inquiries).

Canadian Tire Jumpstart

- ♦ **What it pays:** up to \$300 per child per year toward registration fees and equipment, and camps of five days or more, paid to the club.
- ♦ **Who:** kids aged 4 to 18 from families who meet Jumpstart's income guidelines.
- ♦ **When:** apply before the program starts, between roughly January 15 and November 1. Decisions take six to eight weeks.
- ♦ **How:** go to jumpstart.canadiantire.ca and choose Individual Child Grants. The payee is MJ Boxing Inc. (Moose Jaw Boxing).

What the club does

1. Register your kid first and tell us you are applying. We hold the spot.
2. Come to the gym and we will fill out the forms with you. Bring your Notice of Assessment.
3. If KidSport or Jumpstart calls the club to confirm, we answer the same day.
4. When the money comes in, we apply it to your kid's fees and tell you what, if anything, is left. If a grant does not cover everything, talk to us. No kid is turned away over money. Questions: info@mjboxing.ca or (306) 313-9605, ask for Adam.
